Initial and follow-up appointments are available. Patients do not need to visit Seattle Children's hospital unless they require surgery or certain diagnostic testing. We offer:

- Epilepsy clinic 5 days a week, telehealth appointments available
- First seizure evaluation
- Diagnosis, treatment and education
- Expanded EEG capacity: routine EEGs and at-home EEG hook-ups
- Social work services, medication assistance
